JESUS CHRIST'S TRANSFIGURATION

Luke 9:28–36 (cf. also Matthew 17:1–9 and Mark 9:2–9)

One day Jesus took three of His disciples, Peter, John, and James, with Him up on a mountain to pray. The Bible does not indicate the name of the mountain. Traditionally it is said to have been Mount Tabor.

While He prayed, He was transfigured. His face changed and shone like the sun, and His garment glistened white as snow and beamed like light.

Suddenly Moses and Elijah appeared clearly in a blaze of light. They spoke with Jesus about “His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem”.

Then Peter said to Jesus, “Master, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.”

Just as he said this, a cloud came and overshadowed them. A voice from heaven was heard, saying, “This is My beloved Son. Hear Him.”

When the voice had ceased, Jesus was found alone—the witnesses from yonder world were no longer there.
