	<p>“And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also” (John 14: 3).</p>
	<p>“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ...” (Matthew 28: 19).</p>
	<p>“... and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut” (Matthew 25: 10).</p>
