This document provides you with a minimum guide on how to present the lesson.

How to prepare and present the lesson

Below are some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

Step	Action
1.	<p>Access the New Apostolic Church Website by keying-in or clicking on the following link from WhatsApp:</p> <p>https://bit.ly/3NACSSHS</p>
2.	<p>Gather the following tools to ensure that you are ready for the lesson:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bible • The PDF lesson that is already prepared • Child’s workbook and pencils, crayons, etc. • The Video Clip which is an additional optional resource tool <p>Note:</p> <p>2.1: An ideal time preferably to present the lesson is after the Sunday morning service in line with the normal Sunday School time to maintain the routine.</p> <p>2.2. Please keep the lesson as concise as possible, bearing in mind the retention span (to focus on the lesson) of our children – you know your child best. <i>Sunday School normally does not exceed 45 minutes.</i></p> <p>2.3: The lessons are class specific (i.e. SS, RI or Confirmation).</p> <p>2.4: Please contact your SS teacher if you need any of the above resources.</p>
3.	<p>Pray (see the prayer at the end of this document) and ask God to use you as a tool to present the lesson the way He would want us to present it.</p>

How to prepare and present the lesson

We continue to share some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

Step	Action
4.	Create a pleasant (disturbance free) learning environment where you and the children are at the same level Example: Sit on the mat or at a table
5.	Read through the lesson. Re-read the lesson so that you understand it. Watch the video clip of the lesson to get a better understanding of the lesson.
6.	Make notes for yourself on important points that you would like to remember.
7.	Understand the objective of the lesson that your child must remember.
8.	Present the lesson to your child by telling the story. You can even read the story if you like.
9.	Show your child the video and recap on the meaning/purpose of the lesson.
10.	Refer your child to the activity in the child's workbook.
11.	Pray, or ask your child to pray and close the lesson.

Available tools in terms of Home Schooling

Herewith some tools to enhance the quality of the lesson:

1. WhatsApp chat the lesson with another Sunday school 4 family.
2. Discuss with other parents to obtain clarity regarding the lesson before it is presented.
3. Feel free to conduct your own research for additional information.



The Lesson

Lesson Title	Moses' calling
Text	Exodus 3 and 4; Acts 7: 29-35
Lesson Objective	The children learn that God gave Moses an important commission and promised to help him.

Lesson Summary:

- Moses was tending the sheep on Mount Horeb when suddenly he saw flames flaring up from a bush, yet the bush itself did not burn.
- Moses then heard the voice of God.
- He was commissioned to return to Egypt and lead the people of Israel to the land of Canaan.
- Moses had grave misgivings as to whether he should accept God's commission, because he could not speak well.
- God strengthened Moses through miraculous signs and told him that his brother, Aaron would be his mouthpiece.
- God also spoke to Aaron.
- Aaron and Moses met again after many years on Mount Horeb from where they left for Egypt together.
- They summoned the elders of the people of Israel who believed in Moses' calling and were overjoyed that God had finally heard their prayers.

What does this lesson mean for us today?

- Just like Moses, God may also commission you to do something important for Him.
- You may also doubt whether you can do it, but don't forget, God is always with you.
- Trust Him.



Some questions that we can ask:

1. When Moses was tending his sheep on Mount Horeb what did he see?
A: He saw a bush that was engulfed in flames, but the bush itself was not burning.
2. Who spoke to Moses from this bush?
A: God.
3. What did God commission Moses to do?
A: To return to Egypt and lead the people of Israel to the land of Canaan.
4. Did Moses accept this commission immediately?
A: No, because he said he could not speak well.
5. Did Moses go to Egypt to lead the people to Canaan?
A: Yes, because God gave him the strength and his brother Aaron went with him as his mouthpiece.
6. If God commission you to do something important for Him what would you do, and Why?
A: Let the child answer this question.
