**Jesus in Nazareth.**

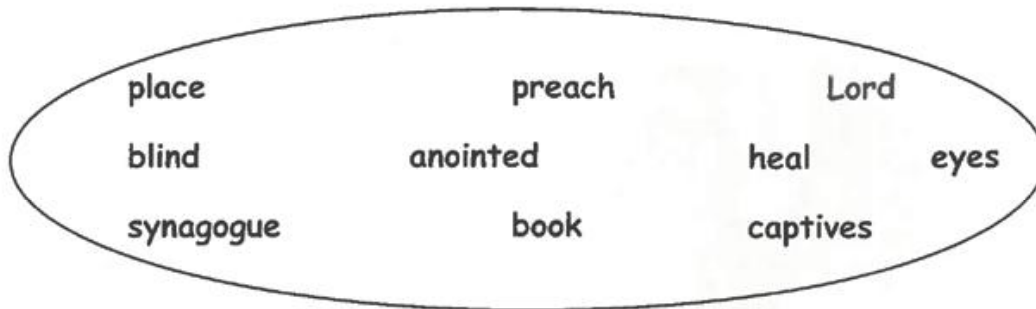
Text: Luke 4:16-30
